Schedule	Monday–Friday, 8:30 AM–4 PM (June and July) This job requires a commitment of 7.5 hours a day on weekdays for seven weeks during the summer.

Summary

Camp counselors work directly with children who attend our Camp Roberts summer day camp. Counselors interact with children individually and in a group setting, and work closely with other counselors. There are six weeks of camp, and one week before camp for planning and preparation. Ages range from Kindergarten through 6th grade.

Essential Duties

- Work closely with the Camp Director and other counselors to create a safe and fun environment where children are shown God’s love
- Be involved with daily activities, such as chapel, games, and indoor and outdoor recreation
- Connect with campers; be available to listen to them, answer questions, and discuss God’s word with them
- Help maintain order and structure throughout the day
- Complete various chores in rotation with other counselors

Skills and Qualifications

- Must exemplify and model Christian behaviors and values, and be in agreement with the Lima Rescue Mission Statement of Faith
- Van drivers must have driving record that is acceptable to our insurance provider
- Must be available for scheduled activities
- Complete a background check with no offenses that would prohibit working with children
