## About the Mission

Lima Rescue Mission offers help and hope to those who are facing a time of crisis. We provide physical and spiritual care to people in need, with the goal of seeing lives transformed. We are guided by biblical principles as we carry out our mission.

### A history of caring

The Mission was established in 1906 by Rev. Adam Welty as a continuation of a ministry to some of the most destitute people in our city. As we follow in the footsteps of those who served before us, we seek to remain faithful to the Lord and continue a ministry that provides care for physical needs while proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ.

### Your support

We are funded by donations from individuals, businesses, churches, and other organizations that want to be involved in helping people in need in our community. We do not receive funding from any government or other agencies. Your support makes a difference as we invest in the lives of others.

## Men's Ministry

The Mission provides a safe and caring environment for poor and homeless men as they take steps to get their life back on track. We expect to see individuals making positive changes and working toward becoming independent, and we provide support, guidance, and encouragement as they do so.

### Physical care

Overnight shelter is provided to those in need, and we offer transitional housing for low-income individuals. Breakfast and supper are provided daily. Clothing and a variety of personal care items are distributed as needed. We work closely with each person, and their time in our shelter helps to provide stability as they establish a daily routine and begin working through issues.

### Spiritual care

We hold chapel services daily, and offer Bible studies and classes that cover a variety of topics throughout the week. Individual biblical counseling is also available.

## Children's Ministry

Our children's ministry began in the 1920s with Bible classes held at the Mission. Over the years there have been changes in programs, but the gospel message remains at the center of all that we do. We are investing in the lives of children facing adversity as we build and maintain personal connections and teach biblical values through a variety of activities.

### After school activities

The after school ministry features crafts and games, worship and a Bible lesson, outdoor time, tutoring, and a meal.

### Camp Roberts

Our summer day camp includes a full day of fun and educational activities. We have chapel in the morning and incorporate the Bible lesson throughout the day's activities. Kids take part in crafts, games, and swimming. They also have the opportunity to learn about and experience nature first-hand as they go on hikes through the woods.
